

PERMITTED TREE SPECIES

Tree Commission
Village of Versailles

Suggested tree list for trees to be planted in public right of way within the Village.

SMALL TREES

Less than 20 feet high at maturity; recommended planting strip not to be less than 2 feet wide.

Amur Maple, Globe Norway Maple, Sprizam Serviceberry Single trunk, "Crusader" Thornless Cockspear Hawthorn, American Spirit Crabapple, Harvest Crabapple, Spring Gold Crabapple, Madonna Mazam Crabapple, Red Barron Snow Crabapple, Velvet Pillar Crabapple, Cleveland Select Callery Pear.

MEDIUM TREES

Trees 20 to 40 feet high at maturity; recommended planting strip not to be less than 3 feet wide.

Hedge Maple; Crimson King Norway Maple, 'Supszam' Red Maple; Shadblow Serviceberry; Upright European Hornbeam; Imperial Honeylocust, Sunburst Honeylocust; Snowdrift Crabapple, Spring Snow Crabapple, Redbud Crabapple.

LARGE TREES


Exceeding 40 feet at maturity; recommended planting strip not less than 4 feet wide.

Thornless Honeylocust (Shademaster, Skyline); Norway Maple (Cleveland, Columaire, Emerald Queen, Crimson King); Red Maple (Columaire, October Glory, Red Sunset, Franksred); Sugar Maple (Green Mountain, Wright Brothers); River Birch (single trunk); Red Oak, English Oak, Pin Oak, Pyramidal English Oak, Scarlet Oak, Shumard Oak, Swamp Oak, Shingle Oak; Black Tupelo; Sweetgum; London Plane Tree; Silver Linden, Greenspire Linden; Tulip Tree; Pioneer Elm, Homestead Elm, Regal Elm; Maidenhair Tree (male); Kentucky Coffee Tree.

Suggested tree list for lottery trees planted on private property outside public right of way area within the Village.

Visibility Area



Visibility area on private property: No eye level plant material to be planted within this area. Shrubbery to be maintained at a maximum height of 3 feet and tree foliage under 8 feet above ground level.

Tree list for public right of way are acceptable for private property.

Suggested tree list for trees to be planted on private property.

SMALL TREES (less than 20 feet high at maturity).

Japanese Maple(varieties); Flowering Dogwood (varieties); Crabapple (varieties); Star Magnolia; Dwarf Spruce; Dwarf Pine; Weeping Dwarf Cherry; Sullivan Cedar; Fern Leaf Buckthorn; Dwarf Weeping Willow (varieties).

MEDIUM TREES (20 – 40 feet high at maturity).

White Birch, Paper Birch; Paperbark Maple; Crabapple (varieties); Sweet Bay Magnolia; Spruce (varieties); Pine (varieties); Callery Pear; Cherry (varieties); Redbud.

LARGE TREES (over 40 feet high at maturity)

Beech(varieties); Bald Cypress; Chinkapin Oak; Horse Chestnut; Weeping Willow; Black or Sour Gum; Hackberry; Katsura Tree
