Safety Departments

Versailles provides 24 hour emergency service through the dedication and experience of the Village Fire Department, Emergency Medical Services, and Police Department. As a community, Versailles is very proud of its safety departments and that pride shines bright in the 20,000 square foot Emergency Services Facility built new in 2008. This facility houses both the village's Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and the Fire Department.





Schools and Education

Education plays a key role in our success. Versailles Exempted Village Schools opened a brand new K-12 school facility at the beginning of the 2010-2011 school year. With a rigorous math and science based curriculum, Versailles Schools is recognized as one of the state's top school districts based on state proficiency test scores. The Versailles Schools has received State Board of Education recognition having been consistently rated as Excellent with Distinction. It also provides quality extra-curricular activities, and has been recognized for its achievements in these areas as well. With a small student population, our educators are able to provide more individualized assistance, and a well-rounded education. The success of our students speaks for itself.

Edison State Community College and Wright State University Lake campus provide post secondary opportunities within a 25 mile radius to Versailles.

Community Utilities

Versailles is a public power community, and one which APPA (American Public Power Association) has recognized as an RP-3 (reliable, public power provider) community. By having our own electric distribution system, customers need only call our village offices to obtain an immediate response to any electrical utility issue that may arise. In addition to the electric distribution system, Versailles is positioned for the future with a 2006 upgrade to the Water Treatment Plant and a 2011 upgrade to the Wastewater Treatment facility. These upgrades are designed to enable the village to sustain growth for the next 20 years. Public power, together with our other local utilities, provide our citizens the advantage of hometown services at reasonable rates.

Parks and Recreation

After a hard day's work, one will find Versailles a peaceful and relaxing setting to call home. Our residents enjoy various recreational facilities including parks, fitness centers, YMCA, swimming pools, and more. An eighteen hole public golf course is located just outside of our community. An annual Poultry Days Festival is held each year in June, with proceeds providing for many services within the community including the establishment and maintenance of Heritage Park. Tourist come from near and far to view our many beautiful bronze statues gracefully situated throughout the community. These statues have earned Versailles the title of The Sculptural Village.

Transportation

Versailles is located within a 30 to 90 minute drive of several major Midwestern metropolitan cities including Dayton, Cincinnati, and Columbus, Ohio, and Indianapolis, Indiana. Because of its geographic location, Versailles is within a 90-minute air flight of 55% of the population in the United States. Versailles provides access to a major rail line (CSX Transportation) and the Darke County Airport is located within three miles of Versailles.
