Re: Laundry Depo Theft

On March 2, 2016 three subjects went into the Laundry Depo located at 863 East Main St in Versailles, Ohio and broke into the Pepsi machine and attempted to break into the coin machine. During the investigation two subjects Misty D. Karnes and John W. Gretchen were identified and indicted by the Darke County Grand Jury for Felony Vandalism, Felony Tampering with a Coin Machine and Misdemeanor Theft.

On August 15, 2016 Misty D. Karnes appeared in Darke County Common Pleas Court for sentencing by Judge Jonathan P. Hein. Ms. Karnes plead guilty to one count of Felony Vandalism a Felony of the fifth degree and received the following sentence.

Sixty (60) months of Community Control Sanction, To serve 27 days in the Darke County Jail with 27 days credit. Pay restitution of \$4,362.04, Pay court cost within 12 months. Pay court cost. Complete 100 hours of community service work. Abstain from alcohol and illegal drugs.

Comply with any substance abuse/mental health treatment/critical thinking /employment programs as recommended by the Adult Probation Department.

On August 22, John W. Gretchen appeared in Darke County Common Pleas Court for sentencing by Judge Jonathon P. Hein. Mr. Gretchen plead guilty to one count of Felony Vandalism a Felony of the fifth degree and one count of Felony Tampering with a Coin Machine a Felony of the fifth degree and received the following sentence.

Serve 196 days in the Darke County Jail with 51 days credit. Credit is given for future time to be served in Randolph County.

Pay court cost.

Pay restitution of \$4,402.04.
