

MINUTES
Park Board Meeting
July 13, 2017

The Park Board meeting was held at the Indian Creek shelter house and began at 5:15 pm.

Those individuals in attendance were Marilyn Griesdorn, Connie Apple, Ted Baltes, Kent Paulus, and Village Administrator Rodd Hale.

A motion was made by Marilyn Griesdorn, seconded by Ted Baltes to approve the agenda. Vote: all yeas.

A motion was made by Connie Apple, seconded by Marilyn Griesdorn, to approve the minutes from the June 15, 2017 meeting. Vote: all yeas.

Administrator Hale provided information on a number of items including the 2017 pool operations. Connie Apple commented that she had heard the pool wasn't being cleaned correctly. Administrator Hale said he went out and checked the pool when he got the call and the pool looked fine. Administrator Hale mentioned he had received a complaint about a pool light being out and the flags too low during swim meets. He spoke to Megan Keiser who reported the light has been fixed and the swim team handles the flags.

The shuffleboard courts were discussed with Administrator Hale stating they need to be repaired, which means repainted or some type of the surface applied. Comments were made that the shuffleboard courts are not used, which all agreed. However, it would be difficult to utilize the courts for anything else.


Administrator Hale mentioned the scoreboard at the Indian Creek baseball diamond is not working correctly and he has Scott's Electric working on it.

Administrator Hale also mentioned there is increased activity at the Pickle Ball courts in Ward Park and the board members agreed. The Village will be placing a bench for players waiting to play on the Pickle Ball courts. It was decided to take one of the benches inside the shuffleboard court area to Ward Park for the Pickle Ball courts.

The Ward Park diamond #1 drainage was discussed. Marilyn Griesdorn commented the diamond is not draining properly. Administrator Hale mentioned that Street Foreman Brian Gehret stated a conditioner, such as was applied at Heritage Park, was needed to help the diamond drain. The initial estimate is approximately \$5000. Members were concerned whether this was necessary or not and questioned how the conditioner works and are there other options. Administrator Hale said he thought it was mixed in with the diamond surface to keep it from being compacted. He will get more information from Brian Gehret.

It was decided that the next Park Board meeting will be held in Thursday, August 10, 2017 at 5:15 at Shelter House #2 in Ward Park, weather permitting, or at the Village of Versailles Administrative building conference room in case of bad weather.

With no further business to conduct a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Ted Baltes, seconded by Connie Apple. Vote: all yeas.
